

## **Portions of Executive Order 20-37**

### **1. Face Covering Requirement:**

Effective: July 27, 2020 12:01 a.m. until August 26, 2020, 11:59 p.m.

...During this time period, every individual within the State of Indiana shall wear a face covering over the nose and mouth when:

1. inside a business, public building, or other indoor place open to the public. This does not extend, however, to private offices, private workspaces or meetings in which six feet of social distancing can be achieved and maintained between people not in the same household;
2. in an outdoor public space wherever it is not feasible to maintain six feet of social distancing from another person not in the same household; or
3. using public transportation or while in a taxi, private car service, or ride-sharing vehicle;

### **4. Exemptions to Wearing Face Coverings:**

The following people are exempt from this directive to wear face covering but are strongly encourage do so if practicable and without undue risk, or alternatively, are strongly encouraged to wear a face shield:

- f. any person while consuming food or drink, or is seated at a restaurant or other retail food establishment to eat or drink;
14. any person while giving a speech for a broadcast or to an audience if the person can maintain six feet of social distancing from another person not in the same household; or
15. any person attending or engaged in a religious service as he or she must already maintain six feet of social distancing from another person not in the same household.
