## CONCLUSION:

Let's look at these verses together throughout our week with the expectation of renewing ourselves, by God's Spirit, to the saving, keeping, and completing grace of God! ### MONDAY – EPHESIANS 2:1-3

1 And you were dead in the trespasses and sins 2 in which you once walked, following the course of this world, following the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that is now at work in the sons of disobedience— 3 among whom we all once lived in the passions of our flesh, carrying out the desires of the body and the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, like the rest of mankind.

**Let's be brutally transparent here. Who were we without the grace of God in our lives?**

### TUESDAY – EPHESIANS 2:4,5

4 But God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which He loved us, 5 even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ—by grace you have been saved—

**Look closely at verse 4; there something there we talked about a couple of weeks ago. Connect the dots between spiritual death and spiritual life!**

### WEDNESDAY – EPHESIANS 2:6

6 and raised us up with him and seated us with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, **What assurance does God's grace afford us in the passage about the "already" and "not yet?"**

### THURSDAY – EPHESIANS 2:7

7 so that in the coming ages He might show the immeasurable riches of his grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.

**Today, simply allow your heart and mind to meditate on this phrase - "the immeasurable riches of his grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus"**

### FRIDAY – EPHESIANS 2:8

8 For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, 9 not a result of works, so that no one may boast.

**Okay, let's go through this one more time - "What did I do to receive God's Grace?"**

### SATURDAY – EPHESIANS 2:1-3

10 For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.

**According to verse 10, what does a life of Grace look like?**
